### SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Lake Country Christian School is an accredited PreK-12 college preparatory school. The school is fully accredited by ACSI (Association of Christian Schools International) and ICAA (International Christian Accrediting Association), both of which carry the approval of the state of Texas through the Texas Private School Accreditation Commission (TEP SAC). The school opened in 1980 with 35 students and now has an average of 400. Located on a 30-acre campus ten miles northwest of downtown Fort Worth, the school draws students from a wide geographical area and a variety of church backgrounds. LCCS is committed to preparing students for life with a purpose. A balance in academic, spiritual, artistic, physical and social training serves to develop the whole person. Developing Christian character and integrating academic excellence with Christian principles are goals of LCCS.

### CLASS RANK
